##### Day 1 - Ahmedabad Arrival & Sightseeing

- Visit Akshardham Temple in Gandhinagar – a grand spiritual and cultural complex (closed on Mondays)
- Stop at the Sidi Saiyyed Mosque, renowned for its exquisite stone lattice windows
- Explore the Hatheesing Jain Temple, an elegant 19th-century shrine showcasing intricate Jain craftsmanship
- Walk through history at the Sabarmati Ashram (Gandhi Ashram), where Mahatma Gandhi lived and led India's freedom movement
- Drive to Adalaj Stepwell, a stunning 15th-century stepwell built by Queen Rudabai, known for its ornate carvings

Overnight stay at hotel in Ahmedabad.

##### Day 2 - Ahmedabad – Jamnagar – Dwarka

Breakfast at the Hotel

After breakfast, drive towards Dwarka

- En route, visit Bala Hanuman Temple, Jamnagar – a revered shrine dedicated to Lord Ram, world-famous for its uninterrupted chanting of “*Shri Ram, Jai Ram*” since 1964, earning a place in the Guinness Book of World Records.
- Continue your journey to Dwarka.
- In the evening, visit the sacred Dwarkadhish Temple, dedicated to Lord Krishna. Attend the divine Aarti Darshan

##### Day 3 - Dwarka Sightseeing

Early morning, attend the Aarti at Dwarkadhish Temple

After breakfast, proceed for local sightseeing:

- Bet Dwarka – An island believed to be Lord Krishna’s residence with his family. Accessible from Okha, this sacred site also marks where Lord Vishnu is said to have slain the demon Shankhasura. The Krishna temple here is a highlight for devotees
- Nageshwar Jyotirlinga Temple – One of the 12 revered Jyotirlingas of Lord Shiva, making it an important pilgrimage site
- Rukmini Devi Temple – Dedicated to Rukmini, the beloved consort of Lord Krishna, known for its intricate carvings and spiritual significance

#### Day 4 - Dwarka – Porbandar – Somnath

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.

After breakfast, drive to Porbandar and visit:

- Kirti Mandir – The birthplace of Mahatma Gandhi, which includes his ancestral house, Kasturba Gandhi’s house, a museum, and Gandhi’s study room.
- Sudama Temple – Dedicated to Sudama, childhood friend of Lord Krishna
- Continue the journey to Somnath
- In the evening, visit the sacred Somnath Jyotirlinga Temple, one of the 12 Jyotirlingas of Lord Shiva. Attend the Aarti Darshan and enjoy the sound & light show that narrates the temple’s history
