Day 1 - Arrival in Delhi

Day 3 - Delhi to Agra

Breakfast at the hotel

- Drive to Agra – the historic Mughal city
- Agra is famous for its Mughal-era monuments including UNESCO World Heritage Sites
- Upon arrival, transfer to hotel and check-in
- After freshening up, proceed for sightseeing

Agra Sightseeing:

- Visit Taj Mahal – the world-famous symbol of love built by Emperor Shah Jahan for Mumtaz Mahal (*Closed on Fridays*)
- Visit Agra Fort – a magnificent fort built by Emperor Akbar
- Visit Itimad-ud-Daulah's Tomb – also known as the “Baby Taj” or Jewel Box
- Rest of the day free at leisure

Overnight stay at hotel in Agra

Day 4 - Sunrise Taj Mahal Visit & Drive to Jaipur (via Fatehpur Sikri & Chand Baori)

Optional early morning visit to Taj Mahal at sunrise .Return to hotel for freshen up and breakfast. After breakfast, drive to Jaipur – the Pink City

- En route visit Fatehpur Sikri – the deserted Mughal capital built by Emperor Akbar
- Continue to visit Chand Baori – one of the deepest and largest stepwells in India with 3,500 symmetrical steps
- Continue drive to Jaipur
- Upon arrival, transfer to hotel and check-in
- Rest of the day free at leisure

Overnight stay at hotel in Jaipur

Day 5 - Jaipur City Tour

Breakfast at the hotel

- Proceed for Jaipur city tour
- Visit Amber Fort – historic fort built by Raja Man Singh in the Aravalli Hills
- Optional Elephant Ride at Amber Fort (subject to additional charges)
- Photo stop at Jal Mahal – the Water Palace
- Visit Hawa Mahal – the famous Palace of Winds
- Afternoon visit to City Palace Jaipur & Museum – a blend of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture
- Visit Jantar Mantar – an astronomical observatory and UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Evening free for leisure or shopping at local markets (famous for handicrafts, textiles, jewellery, and souvenirs)
