Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrival in Milan

Breakfast at the Hotel

Breakfast at the Hotel

- Start the day with a visit to Verona, the romantic city of Romeo and Juliet, and explore its charming historic center.
- Later, we depart for Venice, arriving around 1:00 PM.
- Upon arrival, enjoy a boat transfer to St. Mark's Square, the heart of Venice.
- Join a guided walking tour to explore the highlights of the City of Canals, filled with history and beauty.
- Witness the famous Murano glass-blowing craftsmanship, a centuries-old Venetian tradition.
