Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrival in Jaipur – The Pink City

Arrive in Jaipur, the capital of Rajasthan, and transfer to your hotel

Learn about the city's rich history:

- Jaipur, popularly known as the "Pink City", gets its name from the rose-colored sandstone used in its old city buildings
- Founded in 1727 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, Jaipur was planned according to the Shilpa Shastra (ancient Hindu architectural treatise) and is uniquely divided into nine rectangular sectors, symbolizing the nine divisions of the universe
- The city was painted pink in 1853 to welcome Prince Albert, giving it the iconic hue it's known for today
- Explore the city at leisure or relax at the hotel after your journey
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Jaipur

Day 2 - Jaipur Sightseeing – Forts, Palaces & Bazaars

Breakfast at the hotel

- Proceed for a full-day Jaipur city tour
- Visit Amer Fort (11 km from Jaipur), the former capital of the Kachhawaha clan of Amber. Enjoy the fort's majestic architecture and its stunning reflection on the lake. (*Elephant ride or Jeep available at own cost.*)
- Explore City Palace, a grand complex of palaces, courtyards, gardens, and museums showcasing rare manuscripts, armors, costumes, carpets, and miniature painting
- Walk to Jantar Mantar, the 18th-century astronomical observatory built by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, still known for its precise calculations
- Evening free for shopping at Jaipur's vibrant bazaars, famous for jewelry, textiles, handicrafts, and antiques
- Return to hotel by own transport for dinner and overnight stay

Day 3 - Jaipur – Jodhpur (325 km / 7 hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel

- Check out and drive to Jodhpur, the Marwar capital famously known as the Blue City, dominated by the cliff-top

Mehrangarh Fort

- Upon arrival, check in at the hotel
- Evening free to explore Jodhpur's textile and antique markets
- Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel

Day 4 - Jodhpur Sightseeing – Forts & Heritage

Breakfast at the hotel

- Visit Mehrangarh Fort, perched on a sandstone hill, exploring its beautifully decorated palaces such as Sukh Mahal, Phool Mahal, and Sheesh Mahal, housing collections of jewelry, costumes, armory, palanquins, and howdahs
- Explore Jaswant Thada, the impressive marble memorial built in 1899 for Maharaja Jaswant Singh II, along with the royal crematorium and cenotaphs
- Afternoon at leisure to relax or explore on your own
- Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel

Day 5 - Jodhpur – Udaipur (260 km / 6 hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel

- Check out and drive to Udaipur, the romantic City of Lakes
- Upon arrival, check in at the hotel
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Udaipur

Day 6 - Udaipur Sightseeing – Palaces, Temples & Gardens

Breakfast at the hotel

- City Palace & Museum – the largest palace complex in Rajasthan, blending Rajasthani and Mughal architecture, with courtyards, pavilions, terraces, and museums showcasing miniature paintings and glass mosaics
- Crystal Gallery – located in Fateh Prakash Palace, featuring an exquisite collection of crystal furniture, décor, and royal artifacts
- Jagdish Temple – a beautiful Indo-Aryan temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu, located in the heart of the city
- Sahelion Ki Bari – the 'Courtyard of the Maidens' with lotus pools, marble pavilions, and elegant fountains, built for the queen
- Shilpagram – a crafts village depicting the lifestyle and handicrafts of Rajasthan's folk and tribal communities
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Udaipur
