Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrival in Ahmedabad

Arrive in Ahmedabad and transfer to your hotel

- In the evening, visit Law Garden Market and the Sabarmati Riverfront for a leisurely stroll and local shopping

Overnight stay at hotel in Ahmedabad

Day 2 - Ahmedabad – Sasan Gir (Approx. 360 km)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel

- Drive to Sasan Gir (*Note: Gir National Park is closed from 15th June to 15th October. During this period, visits will be made to Devalia Park. Devalia Park is also closed on Wednesdays and during heavy rain.*)
- Explore Sasan Gir Lion Sanctuary, home to over 300 Asiatic lions. It is the only place outside Africa where lions can be seen in their natural habitat. The sanctuary spans approximately 1,450 sq km and is the last refuge of Asiatic lions in India
- Learn about Asiatic lions, a subspecies that split from African lions around 100,000 years ago

Overnight stay at hotel in Sasan Gir

Day 3 - Sasan Gir – Somnath (Approx. 60 km)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel

Drive to Somnath and visit:

- Bhalka Tirth – Located in Veraval, this is the sacred site where Lord Krishna is believed to have taken his last breath, struck by an arrow from the hunter Jara
- Triveni Ghat – The confluence of three rivers: Hiran, Kapil, and a mythical river. The ghat offers a serene view and spiritual significance
- Visit Somnath Temple – One of the twelve Aadi Jyotirlingas, built by the Moon God, and a major pilgrimage site. Attend the evening Aarti Darshan

- Enjoy the light and sound show narrating the temple's history

Overnight stay at hotel in Somnath

Day 4 - Somnath – Porbandar – Dwarka (Approx. 250 km)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel

Drive to Porbandar and visit:

- Kirti Mandir – Birthplace of Mahatma Gandhi, including his ancestral house, Kasturba Gandhi's house, a museum, and Gandhi's study room
- Sudama Temple – Built to commemorate the friendship between Lord Krishna and his devoted friend Sudama
- Continue to Dwarka and visit Dwarkadhish Temple, one of India's most revered temples dedicated to Lord Krishna, located in the holy city of Dwarka
- Attend the evening Aarti Darshan at Dwarkadhish Temple

Overnight stay at hotel in Dwarka

Day 5 - Dwarka – Bet Dwarka – Nageshwar – Dwarka

Attend early morning Aarti at Dwarkadhish Temple.

Return to the hotel for breakfast. After breakfast, proceed for sightseeing:

- Bet Dwarka – Also known as Bet Shankhoddar, located 5 km from Okha and 30 km from Dwarka. Believed to be the residence of Lord Krishna with his family and the site where Vishnu defeated the demon Shankhasura. The Krishna temple here is a major highlight for devotees
- Nageshwar Jyotirlinga Temple – One of the 12 revered Jyotirlingas of Lord Shiva, an important pilgrimage site mentioned in the Purana
- Rukmini Temple – Dedicated to Rukmini, the beloved wife of Lord Krishna, showcasing beautiful carvings and spiritual significance

Overnight stay at hotel in Dwarka

Day 6 - Dwarka – Jamnagar – Ahmedabad (Approx. 450 km)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel

- Drive to Ahmedabad, en route visiting Bala Hanuman Temple, Jamnagar – A world-famous pilgrimage site dedicated to Lord Ram, known for the uninterrupted chanting of “*Shri Ram, Jai Ram*” since 1964, recognized by the Guinness Book of World Records. Devotees chant in shifts 24 hours a day.

Overnight stay at hotel in Ahmedabad

Day 7 - Ahmedabad Sightseeing & Departure

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel

City tour of Ahmedabad, visiting:

- Sidi Saiyyed Mosque – Built in 1573, famous for its intricate stone latticework.
- Hatheesing Jain Temple – Constructed in 1850 outside Delhi Gate by Sheth Hatheesing, known for its elaborate Jain architecture.
- Gandhi Ashram (Sabarmati Ashram) – Headquarters of Mahatma Gandhi during India's freedom struggle, offering insight into his life and philosophy.
- Drive to Adalaj Stepwell, a 15th-century architectural marvel built by Queen Rudabai.
- Free time for shopping (if time permits).

- Transfer to airport/railway station for your onward journey.

Next, visit the beach town located in Somnath that is known as the home of Shree Somnath Jyotirlinga temple which is a sacred site that holds a significant spiritual significance. The temple's location on the beach provides a stunning backdrop for your trip.

End your trip with an exciting adventure to Sasan Gir, where you will find the world famous Gir National Park, the final natural habitat for the magnificent Asiatic Lion, together with antelopes and leopards and more than 300 species of birds.
