#### **Day 4 - Tangier – Chefchaouen “The Blue City”**

- Discover the town’s peaceful charm and vivid blue-painted streets, perfect for photography and leisurely exploration.
- Highlights include:
- Strolling through the medina’s winding alleys, filled with artisan shops and local cafés.
- Visiting Ras El Ma Spring, where fresh mountain water flows into the town – a refreshing local gathering spot.
- Hiking or walking up to the Spanish Mosque for breathtaking panoramic views of Chefchaouen and its mountain backdrop.
- Evening at leisure.
- Overnight stay in Chefchaouen.

#### **Day 5 - Chefchaouen – Volubilis – Meknes – Fes**

Depart Chefchaouen and travel south to Volubilis, Morocco’s premier Roman archaeological site.

- Evening at leisure.
- Overnight stay in Fes.
