Itinerary

Day 1 - Haridwar to Barkot (via Mussoorie) : Distance: Approx. 180 km | Duration: 6–7 Hours

Begin your spiritual journey from Haridwar and drive towards Barkot, a scenic town nestled in the lap of the Himalayas. En route, pass through the charming hill station of Mussoorie, where you can enjoy breathtaking viewpoints and refreshing mountain air. Continue your drive through picturesque landscapes, lush valleys, and winding roads leading to Barkot.

Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and relax after the journey. Spend the evening at leisure, soaking in the peaceful surroundings and preparing for the upcoming pilgrimage.

Day 2 - Barkot ? Yamunotri Temple Darshan ? Barkot

Drive Distance: Approx. 45 km (One Way) | Drive Time: 2 Hours (One Way) Trek Distance: 6 km (One Way)

Begin your day with a healthy breakfast at the camp/hotel in Barkot before heading towards **Janki Chatti**, the starting point of the **Yamunotri trek**. From here, embark on a scenic 6 km trek through beautiful valleys and mountain trails leading to the sacred Yamunotri Temple, dedicated to Goddess Yamuna.

Pilgrims may also opt for ponies or palkis (on extra cost) for the trek. Upon arrival, take a holy dip in the natural thermal springs and seek divine blessings at one of the revered Char Dham shrines.

After darshan, return via the same route to Janki Chatti and drive back to Barkot. Relax after a spiritually fulfilling day.

Overnight Stay: Barkot

Day 3 - Barkot to Uttarkashi

Distance: Approx. 100 km | Duration: 4–5 Hours

Start your day with a refreshing breakfast at the camp/hotel in Barkot before proceeding towards Uttarkashi. Enjoy a scenic drive through beautiful river valleys, lush greenery, and winding Himalayan roads, making the journey as memorable as the destination.

Upon arrival in Uttarkashi, check in to your hotel and relax. You can spend the evening at leisure or explore the spiritual charm of this sacred town, often referred to as the "Kashi of the North."

Overnight Stay: Uttarkashi

Day 4 - Uttarkashi ? Gangotri Temple Darshan ? Uttarkashi

Distance: Approx. 100 km (One Way) | Duration: 3–4 Hours (One Way)

Begin your day with breakfast at the hotel/camp in Uttarkashi before heading towards Gangotri, one of the sacred Char Dham destinations. Enjoy a breathtaking drive through the scenic **Harsil Valley**, known for its lush greenery, apple orchards, and stunning Himalayan views.

Upon arrival, visit the holy Gangotri Temple, dedicated to Goddess Ganga, and take in the serene spiritual atmosphere by the banks of the sacred river. After darshan, spend some peaceful moments before returning to Uttarkashi via the same picturesque route.

Relax and unwind after a spiritually enriching day.

Overnight Stay: Uttarkashi

Day 5 - Uttarkashi to Guptkashi

Distance: Approx. 220 km | Duration: 8–9 Hours

Begin your day with breakfast at the hotel in Uttarkashi before embarking on a long yet scenic drive towards Guptkashi. This journey takes you through mesmerizing mountain landscapes, river valleys, and picturesque villages, offering breathtaking views throughout the route.

Though the drive is long, the natural beauty of the Garhwal Himalayas makes it a truly memorable experience. Upon arrival in Guptkashi, check in to your hotel and relax after the journey.

Overnight Stay: Guptkashi

Day 6 - Guptkashi to Kedarnath

Drive: Approx. 30 km (Guptkashi ? Sonprayag) Local Transport: Approx. 5 km (Sonprayag ? Gaurikund) Trek Distance: 16–18 km (One Way) | Duration: 6–8 Hours

Start your day early with breakfast at the hotel in Guptkashi before driving to Sonprayag. From here, take local transport to Gaurikund, the starting point of the sacred trek to Kedarnath.

Begin your spiritual trek through scenic mountain trails, waterfalls, and breathtaking Himalayan landscapes leading to the holy **Kedarnath Temple**, one of the twelve Jyotirlingas of Lord Shiva and a key highlight of the Char Dham Yatra. Pilgrims can also opt for ponies, palkis, or helicopter services (at additional cost) for convenience.

Upon arrival, check in to your accommodation and experience the divine aura of Kedarnath, surrounded by majestic snow-capped peaks.

Overnight Stay: Kedarnath

Day 7 - Kedarnath to Guptkashi

Trek Distance: 16–18 km (Downhill) | **Duration:** 5–7 Hours

Start your morning with breakfast near Kedarnath and soak in the peaceful spiritual atmosphere before beginning your return journey. After darshan at the sacred **Kedarnath Temple**, begin your downhill trek back to **Gaurikund** through scenic mountain trails.

Upon reaching Gaurikund, continue your journey by local transport to **Sonprayag**, followed by a drive back to Guptkashi.

Arrive in Guptkashi, check in to your hotel, and relax after a physically fulfilling and spiritually enriching day.

Overnight Stay: Guptkashi

Day 8 - Guptkashi to Pandukeshwar

Distance: Approx. 200 km | Duration: 7–8 Hours

Begin your day with breakfast at the hotel in Guptkashi before proceeding towards Pandukeshwar, a sacred high-altitude village located at an elevation of around 1,829 meters in the Chamoli district.

Enjoy a scenic drive through the majestic Himalayan roads, passing through beautiful valleys, rivers, and picturesque landscapes along the way. Pandukeshwar, situated about 18 km from **Joshimath** on the route to Badrinath, holds great religious significance and offers a peaceful spiritual atmosphere.

Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and relax amidst the serene surroundings of the Himalayas.

Overnight Stay: Pandukeshwar

Day 9 - Pandukeshwar ? Badrinath ? Mana Village ? Pandukeshwar

Distance: Approx. 25 km (One Way) | Duration: 1 Hour (One Way)

Begin your day with breakfast at the hotel before driving to Badrinath, one of the most sacred Char Dham destinations. Upon arrival, visit the revered **Badrinath Temple** and seek blessings of Lord Vishnu amidst the majestic Himalayan backdrop.

Nearby Sacred Attractions: Visit the holy Tapt Kund, a natural hot water spring believed to have healing properties, followed by Brahma Kapal, a significant site for ancestral rituals. You may also take a short trek to Charan Paduka, known for its spiritual importance.

Explore Mana Village – The Last Indian Village: Proceed to Mana Village, located near the Indo-Tibet border, and explore its iconic attractions including Bhim Pul, the ancient stone bridge, Vyas Gufa, where sage Vyas is believed to have composed the Mahabharata, Ganesh Gufa, and the origin point of the sacred Saraswati River.

After sightseeing, return to Pandukeshwar and relax after a spiritually enriching day.

Overnight Stay: Pandukeshwar

Day 10 - Pandukeshwar to Haridwar / Rishikesh

Distance: Approx. 260–280 km | Duration: 9–10 Hours

Begin your final day with breakfast at the hotel before embarking on your return journey from Pandukeshwar to Haridwar or Rishikesh. Enjoy the scenic drive through the beautiful Himalayan landscapes, river valleys, and spiritual towns along the way.

Upon arrival, you will be dropped at your preferred location in Haridwar or Rishikesh, marking the end of your sacred Char Dham Yatra.

Complete your journey with divine blessings and unforgettable spiritual memories.
