Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrival in Madurai

Pick up from Madurai and drive to Rameswaram

En route, stop at Pamban Bridge, an iconic engineering marvel connecting the mainland to the island

- Proceed to Kumbakonam, a town famous for its temples
- Visit the Navagraha Temples, dedicated to the nine celestial bodies in Hindu astrology
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Kumbakonam
